**Sarah Coomes** – sassy, charming and enigmatic character actor and comic writer - has previously appeared at the Fringe in *Gwynn Williams*, *Domestic Goddess* and as one half of double act, *United Biscuits: High Tea*. She also appeared in last year's *Twilight of the Gods*. She studied at RADA and has written for the BBC and appeared in the acclaimed UK indie film, *The West Wittering Affair*. She is the recipient of an award from the RC Sherriff Trust for the advancement of the arts in Elmbridge, Surrey.
